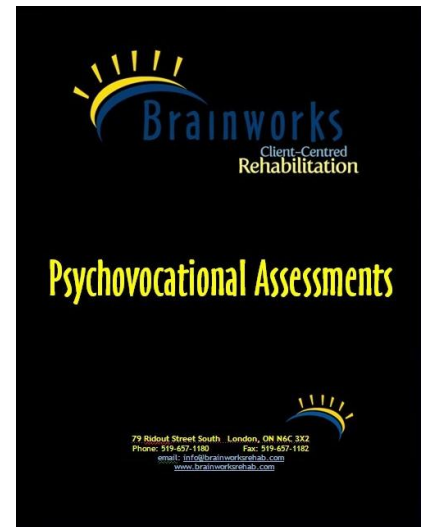


Psychovocational Assessments
