



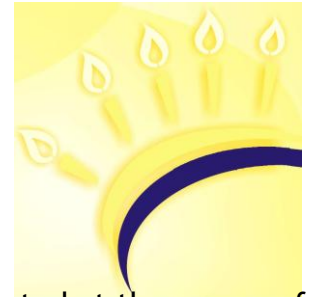
5th Birthday Bash
