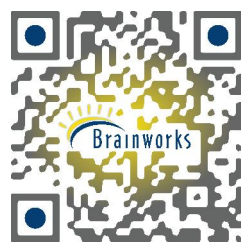

### Assessment

- Assessment of Attendant Care Needs (Form 1)
- Functional In-Home Assessment
- Environmental Accessibility and Home Safety Assessment
- Worksite and Physical Demands Analysis
- Ergonomic Assessment
- Seating and Mobility Assessments

### Consultation

- Train individuals or caregivers in activities of daily living (ADL's) / instrumental activities of daily living (IADL's) such as, bathing, dressing, mobility, shopping, cleaning, etc.
- Provide supervision and monitoring of clinical programming carried out by others, e.g., family, rehab therapists, and educational assistants (EAs)
- Conduct educational seminars and training

### Treatment

- Treatment of physical, affective, and cognitive functioning, as well as rehabilitation and maintenance of self-care, productivity, and leisure
- Recommendation of home, work, and / or school modification(s) Prescription of equipment and assistive devices, e.g., mobility aids, ADL / IADL equipment, and/or assistive technology
